Frequently asked questions

How do I lease Dyson technology?

We've partnered with BNP Paribas Leasing Solutions – a financing provider – to offer leasing for business. Leasing is a simple, affordable and flexible alternative to buying. It's where you pay a monthly amount to use our technology. Your leasing agreement will be with BNP Paribas.

Can I buy my Dyson machines at the end of my lease?

No. You'll need to contact the Dyson Professional Team on 0800 345 7788 or email leasing@dyson.co.uk to discuss a new leasing contract.

Do I automatically own my Dyson machines at the end of my lease?

No. Leasing is the equivalent of renting – you use the machines during your contract and return them at the end.

Will Dyson install, service and maintain my machines?

Yes, we can install, service and maintain your machines, subject to a separate quote.

Can any kind of business lease Dyson technology?

Yes. A wide range of businesses – from SMEs to large internationals – can lease Dyson technology through our financial partner BNP Paribas. Leasing is a cost-effective solution, especially if you don't have the capital available to buy our technology but would like to benefit from its use.
